What degree is substance abuse prevention and early intervention currently a top policy priority in Colorado?



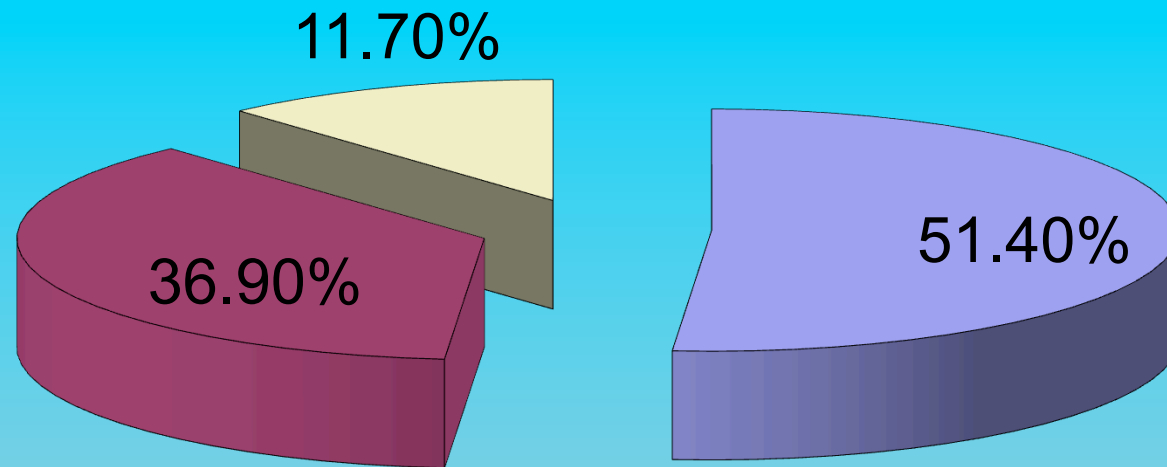

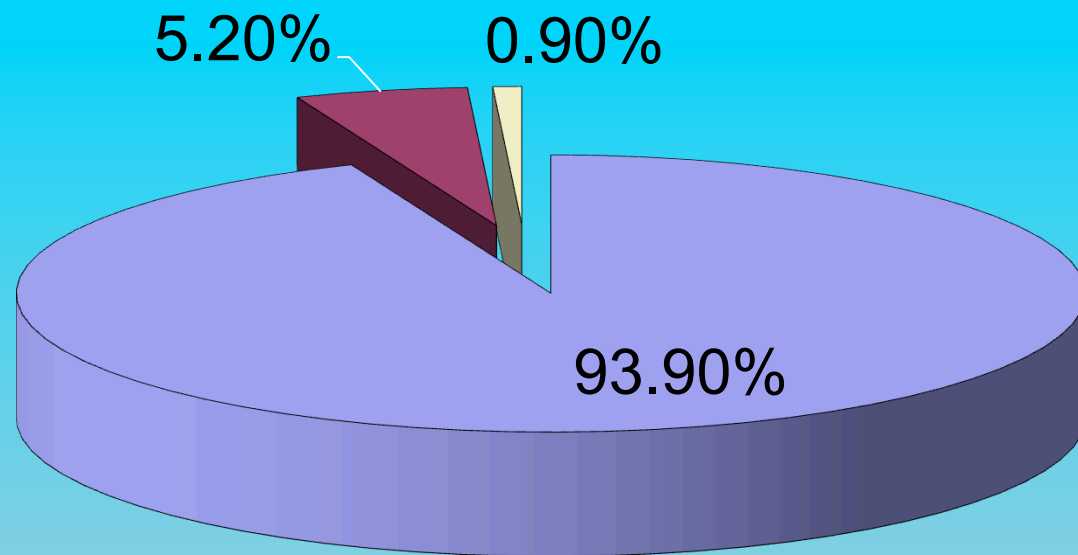

Where do we need to focus our efforts to promote a model of behavioral health integration in Colorado?



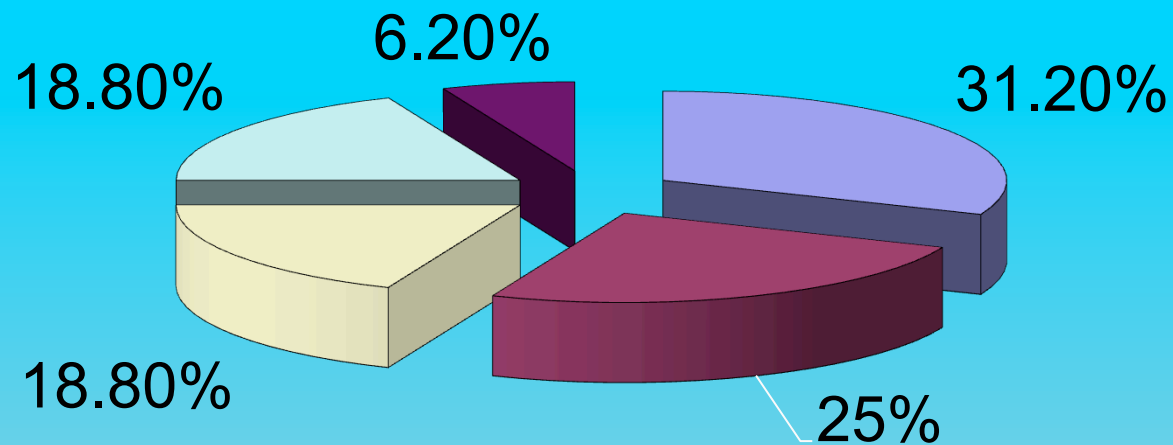
- Training more behavioral health specialists to work in a healthcare setting
